TEMPLATE FOR LIFE GROUP LEADERS

Life Groups are a place where we want our people to connect and get to know each other, pray for each other, service each other, serve together, learn and grow together in our walk with Christ. Remember: relationship before rules.

This is meant to be a guideline for facilitating the Life Groups for the 8 lessons of FOLLOWORSHIP.



1. Most groups share a meal or dessert or have a connect time before starting the lesson.



2. Ask an ice breakers question for the group. For example for the "Lost" lesson, ask "Have any of you actually ever had that feeling of being completely lost or maybe lost track of a child or loved one?" Spend 5-10 minutes letting people share. Ideas for discussion questions are at the end of each lesson.



3. Watch the "Rewind" Video provided on the New Point Website and New Point Facebook page. You can show this easily on a laptop or iPad or if you have a smart TV with Internet you can play it that way.



4. Have the group read through the lesson. You can do this out loud or have them do it silently or ask that they do it before your group meets (ideal). Stop where there is a question to discuss it with the group.



5. Use the scripture verses provided and the discussion questions to talk through the lesson. As leaders you should look through these scriptures and the discussion questions before meeting with your group.



6. End with a challenge for your group to do the Action Step and the end of each lesson.



7. Take prayer requests and pray for your group.
